31	<p>District Councillors Report B. Sofflet advised the Meeting that he has become a member of the District Councils' Audit and Risk Committee following his election. The retiring District Councillor, K Sutton, has become an Alderman of the Council.</p>

The Memorial Hall was discounted due to Health and Safety Concerns and difficult access. It was agreed that the only other possible site in the Village would be The Blacksmiths Arms Car Park. The Deputy Chairman will approach the Licensee for his views on the subject. The Clerk will respond to the Air Ambulance</p>

35	<p>Village Vegetable Allotments</p> <p>A subject mooted at the Village Gardening Club has been the possibility of having Vegetable Allotments in the Village. After discussion it was agreed that the Parish Council has no land to offer and at this moment in time there seems to be no more than a transient interest in the subject.</p>
36	<p>County Councillors Report</p> <p>T Taylor advised the Meeting that the Local Improvement Scheme bids were discussed at a recent County Council Meeting. The 'bids' submitted amount to 196 totalling £3.5M. The Fund Pool is £1.3M. Some applications such as those for Village Gateway signs and modest Projects have been approved, those above £10K will be considered by Committee in July. The Clayworth LIS bid is therefore still in the mix.</p>
